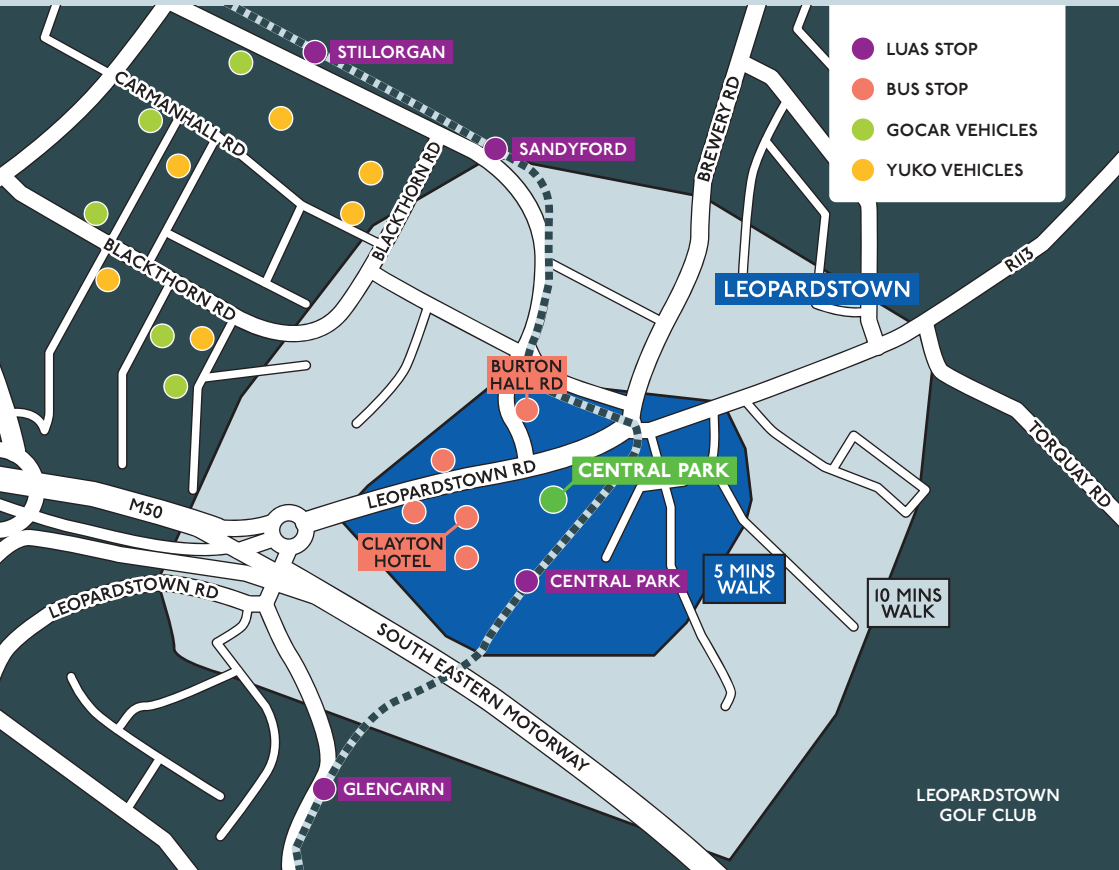

Central Park is approximately 10km south of Dublin city centre, conveniently located on the Luas network, with strong bus connections and easy access to the M50 Motorway and the N11.



YOUR PUBLIC TRANSPORT OPTIONS

TRAVEL BY BUS

From Central Park you can access three local services, all from stops less than a 5-minute walk away!

Service 47 Leopardstown Rd

City Centre – Stillorgan –
Central Park – Stepside

A service approx. every 60 minutes, in each direction, with additional peak period services.

Operated by Dublin Bus.

Service 114 Burton Hall Rd

Rockview – Sandyford – Blackrock

A service every 60 minutes, in each direction.

Operated by Go Ahead Ireland

CENTRAL PARK SHUTTLE

Bank staff can take advantage of the free Central Park shuttle bus services. The shuttle services offer a connection to the city centre and Blackrock station.

The Central Park website is regularly updated with information on the timetable, which you can view by scanning here:



TRAVEL BY LUAS

The Luas Green Line runs direct from Central Park to Brides Glen and Dublin city centre.

Services run every 10 minutes on average, with a service up to every 4 minutes during peak periods.

The Green Line stops at a number of Park and Ride locations including Sandyford (2-minute journey), Stillorgan (3-minute journey), Balally (7-minute journey) and Carrickmines (9-minute journey).

TICKET OPTIONS

LEAP CARDS

Transport for Ireland's Leap Card is a convenient way to pay for public transport across Dublin and the surrounding counties. Leap Card fares are up to a third cheaper than cash single tickets!

Plus, Leap Card users in the Dublin area also benefit from automatic capping, so you'll never spend more than you need to! You can see the daily and weekly caps in the table below:

TAX SAVER TICKETS

Tax Saver commuter tickets are great for people regularly commuting by public transport. The cost of your ticket is deducted from your salary before tax, allowing savings of up to 52%!

Monthly and annual tickets can be purchased for travel by bus, Luas, rail or any combination of the three, with different zones also available, depending on where you're travelling from.

ACTIVE TRAVEL



Cycling, walking and running are great ways to get and stay healthy!

If you live locally, travelling to work by bike or on foot can be a great way to fit exercise into your routine. If your commute is too far, why not consider active travel from a local car park or jumping off the Luas a stop early?

There are shower and locker facilities in the underground car park, across from the cycle storage, for everyone at Central Park to use.

TRAVEL BY CAR

Whilst there are times when it is easy enough to walk, cycle or hop on public transport, for some people and some trips the only realistic option is to travel by car.

The bank benefits from 290 parking spaces across Central Park to assist those needing to travel by car. Access to these spaces is managed through a permit system, you can speak with your line manager about eligibility for a permit.
